	4.1 SA reported that income from StarFest 2018 registrations amounted to £2690 and the raffle raised 116.60 leading to a total income of £2690 Expenses (excluding Forestry Commission fees) for StarFest totalled £1007. Income over expenditure = £1799	

	The forestry commission have yet to invoice for the field/marquee hire at £960 + £275 for car passes totalling £1235.

	6.1 NG reported StarFest was a huge success with 100 attendees. Positive feedback received from a number of attendees during the event and via feedback forms as well as offers from attendees to assist with running the next event.

	6.3 NG to revise field layout/setup instructions to make it easier to set up. 6 people minimum will be required to set out field as 4 was not enough to set field out efficiently	
7.	StarFest 2019	
	7.1 Following the financial review of StarFest 2018, it was agreed that StarFest be held in 2019 as it is still a profitable event for the society. Non-FC running costs should be reduced in 2019 as items such as propane gas bottle will not be required.	
	7.2 NG reports that he intends to implement a nightly visitors option at £10 per night in an attempt to attract more of the SARAS membership to StarFest 2019, who are interested in the event but do not wish to/are unable to camp. Vehicles would be parked over the road/in Dixons Hollow to avoid issues of car headlights. Nightly Visitors would be able to leave at whatever time they wished having paid the barrier fee.
