- 6.2 Summary: The excess expenditure over income for the year was -£835.47. As of 7th May 2023 the society' bank account has a balance of £7429.19.
- 6.3 ND stated that the price of Starfest registrations has gone up this year due to increase costs and due to Forestry England requiring 10% of all registration fees.
- 6.4 ND remarked that the society now has PLI cover for £10 million as this is required by Forestry England

8. Any Other Business

- 8.1 NG proposes to rename the observatory domes located at the Dalby Visitor Centre in remembrance of John Harper including a suitable plaque. All agreed.
- 8.2 ND suggests a reorganisation of the Discord server to better reflect the category of conversations
- 8.3 ND suggest purchasing or making a solar filter for the Unistellar digital telescope
- 8.4 JM asks if the use of home-made solar filters affects the societies PLI cover
- 8.5 ND asks whether imaging workshops suggested by other members could be held after regular monthly meetings is there a time limit on use of the village hall?
- 8.6 ND suggests more ad-hoc observing sessions communicating them out using Discord or WhatsApp. Suggestions are needed for accessible but dark locations for these PS suggests Sinnington farm (although accessibility is an issue), CD suggested Broxa forest site opposite the car park at the top of Reasty Bank.
- 8.7 ND commented that the star chart on South Bay is in a state of very bad disrepair ND to investigate restoration options with North Yorkshire Council.
- 8.8 PS asks for suggestions for speakers at this year's meetings suggests looking further afield for speakers we have not used before. ND suggested reaching out to York University, PS will try to reach out to York Astro Society again. ND to investigate inviting speakers from the Open University.
